- 2. The *i*PSLE is the international version of the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE) taken by Singapore students after six years of education in a Singapore primary school.
- 3. The Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board reserves the right to amend the results shown.
- 4. A candidate's performance is denoted by an Achievement Level (AL), 1 to 8, as shown below. Grades for *i*PSLE subjects are equivalent in standard to the corresponding AL in the PSLE.
