

### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

- 1 The Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board is authorised by the Republic of Singapore to manage national examinations in Singapore. The Board, together with the Ministry of Education (MOE), Singapore and Cambridge Assessment International Education are the joint examining authorities for the General Certificate of Education Normal (Technical) [GCE N(T)-Level] Examination.
- 2 Where a subject is not developed by MOE / Cambridge Assessment International Education, the examining authority for the subject is printed in brackets below the subject title.
- 3 A 4-point grading system is used to show attainment in a subject. Grades A to D are pass grades. Grade A is the highest grade and Grade D the lowest. 'Ungraded' denotes a fail grade.
- 4 The symbol 'T' is used to denote that no grade was awarded to the candidate because of irregularities.
- 5 Where appropriate, subjects are annotated with the following symbols:
  - # Exemption Symbol**  
The candidate was exempted from satisfying the full range of assessment objectives in the papers sat for this subject.
  - + Access Arrangement Symbol**  
The candidate sat for the paper under access arrangements.
  - E\* Symbol**  
The candidate was exempted from the Oral and/or Listening Comprehension component due to valid reasons.
