#### 1. INTRODUCTION

- The Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB), together with the Ministry of Education, Singapore (MOE) and Cambridge Assessment International Education, are the joint examining authorities for the Singapore-Cambridge GCE-Level examinations. The examinations are administered by SEAB.
- All materials submitted for examination purposes (e.g examination scripts, materials submitted for coursework, project work and research work) are deemed as examination materials and their rights shall be assigned to SEAB.
- Before registering for any examination subject(s), you are advised to read the information in this document thoroughly. By registering for the examinations offered by SEAB,
  - you agree to comply with all examination instructions and regulations stipulated in this booklet and other examination documents issued by SEAB, and accept the possible consequences if you breach them.
  - you shall assign your rights in the examination materials to SEAB, and acknowledge that SEAB may collect, use and disclose your data for the purpose of carrying out all functions and duties of the SEAB under the SEAB Act 2003.
- SEAB may issue additional administrative or procedural instructions for the conduct of specific papers
  (e.g.,written papers, oral, and practical papers). You will be informed of the new or updated instructions through
  email notifications to your registered email address. The new or updated instructions will also be published on
  SEAB's website. Unless stated otherwise, they will form part of the examination rules and regulations for the
  examination year, effective from the date of announcement. You should check SEAB's website for any updates
  to the instructions, prior to your examinations.
- The national examination question papers are copyrighted. You are not allowed to post online, publish or reproduce the national examination question papers in any form without permission from SEAB. SEAB will take all necessary actions, including penalties against candidates if there are any copyright infringements.
- No part of this document, whether image, text or otherwise, may be copied, reproduced, published, adapted, modified, distributed, transmitted, communicated and/or stored in any form or by any means without the prior written permission of SEAB.

#### REGISTRATION

## 2.1. REGISTRATION PERIOD AND ELIGIBILITY



You can register for the 2023 Singapore-Cambridge GCE N(T)-, N(A)-, O- and/or A-Level examination(s) through SEAB's Candidates Portal from 29 March 2023 - 11 April 2023, 11.59pm.

Regular updates on registration, examination schedules and important dates will be published on SEAB's website. You are advised to check SEAB's website regularly.

The minimum age requirements and maximum number of registrable subjects for each examination level are indicated below:

School candidates who are enrolled in Government/ Government-Aided/ Independent/ Specialised schools must not register as private candidates. If you are a school candidate, your registration as a private candidate will be invalidated and any paid examinations fees will be forfeited.

#### 2.2. EXAMINATION SUBJECTS

**Science Subjects** with Practical components

If you are registering for a Science subject with a practical paper, you:

- Must have sat the same Science subject(s) previously, **OR**
- are currently attending or will be attending a course of instruction in Science practical at any institute/school. You must complete the course of instruction in Science practical at the institute/school enrolled in.

You are required to declare that you have fulfilled the above requirements at the point of registration. Registration for the subject may be cancelled without a refund of the examination fees if a false declaration is made.

#### **Mother Tongue** Language Subjects

- (a) You may choose to sit for the GCE O-Level and/or A-Level Mother Tongue Language (MTL) subjects during the Mid-Year and/or Year-End examinations. You will need to select either the Mid-Year- or Year-End examinations during the registration period.
- (b) If you have sat the GCE O-Level and/or A-Level Mid-Year MTL examination, you may register to sit the GCE O- Level and/or A-Level Year-End MTL written examination after the release of the Mid-Year results in August 2023. Please note that you will only be allowed to re-sit the written papers.
- (c) You will be advised on the Year-End MTL examination registration procedures and timelines when the Mid-Year MTL examination results are released.
- (d) You will only receive results reflecting the subjects which you sat for in the examination year, once the GCE-Level examination results are released. If you sat for your MTL subject in both the Mid-Year and Year-End examinations, the better result of the two sittings will be reflected on your certificate, provided you obtained an overall pass in your MTL subject.

- 2.2.1. You may refer to the list of subjects offered for the GCE N(T)-, N(A)-, O- and A-Level examinations, as well as the subjects which are not allowed to be taken together, in <a href="Annex A">Annex A</a>. Any pre-requisites will be mentioned with the subjects.
- 2.2.2. Please note that the following subjects are not offered to private candidates.
  - Subjects with coursework components
  - H3 subjects
  - Mother Tongue Language Syllabus B (MTL Syllabus B)

Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents and International Students who wish to register for MTL Syllabus B will need to write to <u>SEAB</u> to seek approval.

- 2.2.3. Details of the examination requirements for each subject are found in the syllabus documents published on <a href="SEAB's website">SEAB's website</a>.
- 2.2.4. A subject may not be offered if it has less than 20 registered candidates in a particular examination year. You will be informed in such situation and you may choose another subject. Refund(s) will be given for the subject if you choose not to register for a replacement subject.



• It is **compulsory** for you to **sit for all registered components** of a subject, such as the Oral, Listening Comprehension, Practical and Written papers. This is regardless of whether you had sat for those papers in previous years.

You will be recorded as 'Absent' for the subject and you will not receive an examination grade if you did not sit for one or more components. This is unless you have been granted exemption by SEAB for the component(s).

- If you sit for the examinations of duplicate subjects\* in the same examination year or
  across different examination years, only <u>one</u> of the subject results can be used in the
  aggregate computation for progression.
  - \* Duplicate subjects refer to:
  - The same subjects offered at different examination levels. An example is GCE N(A)-Level Mathematics Syllabus A and GCE O-level Mathematics.
  - Different subjects offered at different examination levels that have contents overlapping. An example is GCE N(T)-Level Science Syllabus T and GCE N(A)-Level Science (Physics, Chemistry).

#### 2.3. EXAMINATION FEES

- 2.3.1 The amount of examination fees payable will be based on your citizenship status at the **point of registration**. There will be no refund of your examination fees if you have changed your citizenship status after your registration.
- 2.3.2 The examination fee for each subject may differ depending on the subjects registered for.
  - You may refer to **Annex A** for the respective subject fees for this examination year.
- 2.3.3 All examination fees are subjected to the prevailing Goods and Services Tax (GST). Examination fees are not transferable from one examination year to another, or from one candidate to another.

## 2.3.4 Mode of Payment

You may pay for your examination fees via credit/debit card or PayNow in Candidates Portal by the registration deadline of 11 April 2023, 11.59pm. You will not be registered for the examinations if you did not make payment by the deadline or if your payment is not successful.

Funds in your Edusave account and Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA) cannot be used to pay for your examination fees.

## 2.4. AMENDMENTS TO REGISTERED SUBJECTS

- 2.4.1 You are advised to check your registration details and the examination subjects which you are registering for carefully before submitting them online.
- 2.4.2 You may refer to the information on the amendment of subjects below:

#### 3. WITHDRAWAL AND REFUND

#### 3.1. WITHDRAWAL FROM THE ENTIRE EXAMINATION

- 3.1.1 An application for withdrawal from the entire examination must be submitted via <u>Candidates Portal</u> by **12 September 2023, 11.59pm** in order to be considered.
- 3.1.2 SEAB will send you an acknowledgement within 5 working days of the receipt of the withdrawal application and documents.



- You will **NOT** receive any results for any subjects or components of subjects that you have sat for if you withdraw from the examinations.
- Your results will be invalidated if the examination results have already been released to you (For example, the Mid-Year written examination results).

#### 3.2. Refund

- 3.2.1 A 50% refund of the subject fee(s) paid (inclusive of GST), for the GCE N(T)-/N(A)-/O-/A- Level examinations, may be provided if:
  - Your withdrawal request is submitted to SEAB by 30 June 2023, 11.59pm.
  - You have not sat for any component of the registered subject that you are withdrawing from.

You will receive the refund approximately one month after your withdrawal request is approved by SEAB.

#### 3.3. APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO TERTIARY INSTITUTIONS

- 3.3.1 If you are in the process of applying for admission to tertiary institutions but wish to resit the GCE O- or A-Level examinations, please register during the registration period from 29 March 2023 to 11 April 2023, 11.59pm to avoid late registration fees.
- 3.3.2 You may apply for a full refund (less subjects which you had sat for) of the examination fees with the supporting documents confirming your tertiary admission via Candidates Portal by 30 Jun 2023, if you subsequently gain admission to the tertiary institutions. There will be no refund of examination fees after 30 June 2023, 11.59pm.

#### **ACCESS ARRANGEMENTS**

Access Arrangements (AA) are examination arrangements granted to candidates with specific learning and physical needs, to enable them to sit the national examinations without compromising the assessment objectives. These arrangements are not intended to give the candidates an unfair advantage over other candidates taking the same examination.

If you require AA to sit the examination(s) due to specific learning and physical needs diagnosed before the examinations, you may apply for AA by following the instructions below.

APPLICATION FOR ACCESS ARRANGEMENTS 4.1





- Please submit your AA application by 24 April 2023, 11.59pm via the Candidates Portal. You may submit AA applications only after you have registered successfully for your examinations.
- AA applications may take up to four (4) months to review. Late applications may not be accepted or approved due to an insufficient time for review.
- 4.1.1 The outcome of your AA application will be released to you via Candidates Portal. You will receive an email notification informing you to download the AA outcome letter. If you do not see the email notification by the stipulated deadline, please check your email's "junk mail" folder. For AA applications submitted by 24 April 2023, 11.59pm, the AA outcome will be available by the following months:
  - May 2023 for the Mid-Year MTL examinations
  - June 2023 for the Year-End examinations
- You must download the AA outcome from Candidates Portal and present the AA outcome letter to the examination personnel before the start of your examination(s), so that they can verify any AA granted by SEAB.
- 4.1.3 To withdraw from any AA that was granted, please submit the withdrawal via email to SEAB CS Admin@seab.gov.sg at least five working days before the date of the examination requiring the AA. SEAB will not reinstate the provision of AA once the request for withdrawal has been approved by SEAB. If your withdrawal application is submitted late, the application may not be accepted or approved in time. You may still be considered to have made use of the approved AA during the national examinations and your results will correspondingly be annotated. Please refer to 4.2.2 for more information.

#### 4.2. ANNOTATION ON RESULTS

Types of Access Arrangements with Annotation Your results will be annotated for the following AA:

- Extra time allowance (including preparation time for oral examination);
- Exemption from satisfying the full range of assessment objectives in a subject (e.g. exemption from oral, listening comprehension etc.);
- · Modification of examination papers;
- Use of word processor facilities and other computer aids;
- · Use of Reader or Scribe; and
- Practical assistance in areas such as handling of apparatus during the practical examinations, using instruments or graph plotting.

Types of Annotation Symbols

There are three types of annotation symbols. The explanation for the symbols are as follows:

#### • Exemption Symbol (#)

'The candidate was exempted from satisfying the full range of assessment objectives in the papers sat for this subject.'

#### • Access Arrangement Symbol (+)

'The candidate sat the paper under access arrangements.'

#### • E\* Symbol

'The candidate was exempted from the Oral and/or Listening Comprehension component due to valid reasons.'

4.2.1 SEAB annotates a candidate's results only when there are significant modifications for an examination. This is to indicate factually that the candidate had taken the examination under conditions that are different from the standard prescribed testing conditions, and it is done to uphold the integrity of the system.

SEAB will not reveal the details regarding the non-standardised conditions, even if there are requests for them.

4.2.2 If you would like to withdraw your AA application for a subject, you must submit the withdrawal application at least five working days before the date of the examination of the subject. Otherwise, your results will still be annotated. This is even if you did not make use of the approved AA during the national examinations.
