- 1 As an artist or designer, identify a location or locations to celebrate the first graduates of the University of the Arts Singapore (UAS) and create a mural or sculpture or series of works.

In your written report, explain your reasons for selecting the location(s), and the rationale for the celebration of the UAS first class, including the artists and/or the artworks that influenced your creation.

- 2 The Health Promotion Board will select six Healthy365 users to reward their impressive healthy lifestyle change with an all-expenses paid weekend getaway for two in Singapore. The most sensible healthy lifestyle transformations for a range of participants in three age groups: 'teenagers', 'adults', and 'seniors' will comprise the winners.

As a designer, develop **two** designs for social media posts for publicity. Your written report should include a rationale for how you organised the different participants and their age groups, your choice of visuals and layout to highlight a healthy lifestyle message.

- 3 The ArtScience Museum has invited artists, designers and digital content creators to propose an exhibition curated to present the creative ways artists and designers have leveraged Artificial Intelligence (AI) to enhance their creative process.

Research and select **four** artists **or** designers with accompanying work that leveraged AI to enhance their creative process for the exhibition. Your written report must include identifying your theme(s), how AI supports new creative possibilities as a key message for the exhibition and a layout of how these works will be experienced and understood by the viewer.
